HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER DESIGNATED A HIGH PERFORMING AGENCY

Denver, CO -- The Housing Authority of the City and County of Denver (DHA), the largest housing authority in the state and the Rocky Mountain region was designated a “High Performer” by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Public Housing Assessment System. DHA’s High Performer designation is based on four business indicators-- 1) Physical Condition of Portfolio; 2) Financial Condition; 3) Management Operations; and 4) Resident Service and Satisfaction.

In 2007, a year of transition and new leadership under the agency’s executive director, DHA’s designation as a High Performing housing authority continues to reflect on the good work being done by all involved at the Authority. “This designation exemplifies DHA’s mission to serve the residents of Denver by developing, owning and operating safe, decent and affordable housing in a manner that promotes thriving communities. “ said DHA Executive Director Ismael Guerrero.

According to Guerrero, “Moving forward, DHA Board and Staff are steadfast in establishing high standards through excellence in management by intergrading proven and practical business practices.”

DHA manages and administers 10,367 dwelling units and Section 8 vouchers, serving over 24,000 residents throughout the City and County of Denver.
