**TRINIDAD RODRIGUEZ APPOINTED AS BOARD MEMBER
DENVER HOUSING AUTHORITY**

DENVER, CO -- The Denver Housing Authority (DHA) announced today that Mr. Trinidad Rodriguez has been appointed by Mayor John Hickenlooper and confirmed by the Denver City Council as a member of its Board of Commissioners. Mr. Rodriguez will serve on the Board through 2014.

Mr. Rodriguez holds the position of senior vice president with the George K. Baum & Company, Education and Nonprofit Finance Group, joining the firm in 1999. In this position Mr. Rodriguez has financed over \$800 million in tax-exempt bonds for independent schools, higher education and nonprofit institutions. Prior to joining George K. Baum, Mr. Rodriguez served as a policy adviser in the Colorado Governor's Office. He holds a BA in Economics from the University of Massachusetts at Amherst.

Mr. Rodriguez also serves on the boards of Urban Peak and the New America School and is active in several other community and nonprofit organizations.

DHA was established in 1938 as a quasi-municipal corporation with an annual budget of \$142 million. DHA is one of Denver's largest subsidized landlords, serving 24,000 very low, low and middle income residents and managing over 10,500 dwelling units located throughout the city.
