Mid-Rise Building Type

Casa Loma Apartments is a Denver Housing Corporation (DHC) Project-Based Assistance (PBA) Section 8 site program designated for elderly and disabled residents. The building consists of 83 units featuring a mix of one and two bedrooms along with accessible units.

A comprehensive modernization of the Casa Loma Apartments was completed in 2014. Building improvements included: a reconfiguration of the first floor, a private resident entrance, four additional units, a fitness room and additional office space for resident services. Other building improvements include the installation of energy efficient systems and airconditioning, elevators, new balcony railings, exterior painting and energy efficient windows.






Average Family Size


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Number of School Aged Children
