NON-DISCRIMINATION NOTICE

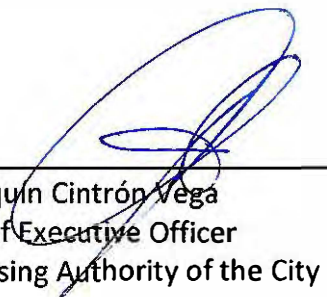
The Housing Authority of the City and County of Denver (Housing Authority) provides housing, program activities and services for low and moderate income people in accordance with the requirements of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and with the policies of the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority. As a recipient of federal financial assistance from HUD, the Housing Authority must comply with the provisions of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, and its implementing regulations located at 24 CFR Part 8, "Non-discrimination based on handicap in federally assisted programs and activities of the Department of Housing and Urban Development."

The Housing Authority does not discriminate on the basis of disability in the admission, access to, or treatment in its programs or activities. Additionally, the Housing Authority does not discriminate on the basis of disability in its employment.

The Housing Authority will require its employees, agents and contractors to adhere to the provisions of this policy.

The Housing Authority has designated a 504 Coordinator pursuant to 24 CFR Section 8.53, to coordinate compliance with the non-discrimination requirements contained in 24 CFR Part 8. The 504 Coordinator is located at 1035 Osage Street, Denver, Colorado 80204, phone number 720-932-3091.
